Nurse Practitioner / Physician Assistant / Physician Seasonal

We are in search of a Nurse Practitioner, Physician Assistant or Physician who is experienced, comfortable with independent decision making in primary care/urgent care, customer service oriented, and enjoys the Sierra Nevada mountains in the summer.

Candidates must be willing to support a family friendly and positive outdoor (family camp) environment. Candidates need to have good customer service skills, knowledge of primary, urgent care, occupational medicine, and an ability to work with EMT support staff.

Contracted Assignment: 8-hour shifts on clinic days which are normally Monday – Friday from 8am to 5pm throughout the summer. This is a shared position with other Advanced Practice Care providers. Practitioners may work full week(s) or individual days.

Location: Pinecrest California, at UC Berkeley's Alumni Camp, Lair of the Golden Bear, approximately 30 miles east of Sonora. Physical address is 1 Camp Blue Road, Pinecrest CA.

Benefits: Hourly rate as an independent contractor, plus;

- All meals (breakfast, lunch & dinner) for practitioner and family in camp restaurants.
- Lodging in either camp cabin or rental home nearby.
- Family members may participate in Camp activities during your assignment as if they were paying guests.
- Malpractice insurance coverage
- Simple paperwork (basic SOAP notes) – no medical billing, no EMT, paper/pen

Requirements: California NP or PA licensing required. A bachelor's degree is required. Current BLS/ CPR Certification. Work Experience: At least 2 years of experience.

Responsibilities: Candidate shall exercise his/her independent professional medical judgment, determining the appropriate treatment for patients in accordance with good medical practice as well as the prevailing recognized professional standards. Documentation is paper based. No fees are charged. Medical director backup is available by phone. 6 clinic hours, 2 roaming hours per day. Care is focused on unscheduled illness and injury of weekly family guests and college aged camp staff. Continuity of care for occupational conditions of the staff is important. Decisions about recommending further care at the Emergency department in Sonora is your responsibility. EMT's are first responders for scene emergencies and may ask for your input on medical management and referral to the local ER, or activation of EMS. Any procedures, specifically suturing, is referred to the local emergency department.
